Once again, as I write, I hope that this issue of Rufford Park Post finds you and your family well.

It has been a quite exceptional week and the fact that this newsletter did not get published at its usual time shows how very busy we have all been in anticipation of a school closure and then in response to the Government's announcement on Wednesday. The requirement for schools to continue to stay open for some children generated a significant amount of operational work for us but we managed to communicate with the families we needed to and have a plan in place for Monday. I think it is good that we are open - there can't be many better purposes at the moment than being an exceptional support for vulnerable young people and those parents whose work is critical to the COVID-19 response.

Whilst school is closed to the majority of our children, we will continue to communicate with you on a weekly basis through Rufford Park Post. It will be published in the <u>News and Events</u> section on the website. In addition to this, all teachers will post a weekly message on their class website page with an update on work and well-being.
