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Headteacher's news:

It has been a good first week back after the long summer break and the children have settled back well into school routines. I have enjoyed seeing the children as we have gathered for assemblies and look forward to spending more time in class over the course of the coming year. In mid-August I <u>published plans</u> outlining how we will continue to make adjustments to keep the whole school community safe as we continue to live during these unprecedented times.

The main points to note are:

- we continue to have a one-way system in place for drop off / pick up
- we still have staggered start and end times to the school day (see below) although these are slightly tighter than previously
- parents/carers do not need to wear masks on site outside but will do if they come into school (e.g. meet the teacher sessions next week)
- we continue to follow good hygienic procedures (handwashing etc...) and we keep the school well ventilated
- we no longer have bubbles and zones
- lunchtime procedures are very similar to last year except we do not have such regimented sittings
- contacts will no longer be identified if anyone in school tests positive for Covid so we will not be closing whole classes
