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Headteacher's news:

It has been a short week in school days but has felt much longer.

Test weeks always feel like this from my experience and we have had both Y6 and Y2 busy with their Key Stage Tests. The Y2 pupils will continue with their tests next week as we are allowed to be more flexible with the delivery. The Y6 children have followed a very tight timetable and have now completed their assessments in 'Grammar, punctuation and spelling', 'Reading' and 'Mathematics'. We assess writing using a teacher assessment judgement as opposed to a test.

We had a monitoring visit from the Local Authority on Thursday morning to check that the administration and storage of the test material was 'in order' and we were commended for our organisation and delivery. The children were also praised for how calm and focussed they were during this visit and this was the case for all the tests they have done this week.

Assessments have not dominated the week though and our hatchlings in Nursery have attracted a great deal of attention across school.


There were **no assemblies this week** as the hall was being used for the Y6 pre-SATs breakfast club.
