Government help with childcare costs for parents.

Childcare Choices is a cross government campaign that aims to make more parents aware of the financial support on offer to help them with the costs of childcare. While most families in the UK are entitled to some form of support, many are missing out because they simply don't know they are eligible. From April, working parents can get even more help with their childcare costs - starting with 15 hours childcare for 2 year olds. The

<u>Childcare Choices website</u> helps parents to find out what they might be eligible for, now and in the future, and when to apply.
