Headteacher's news:

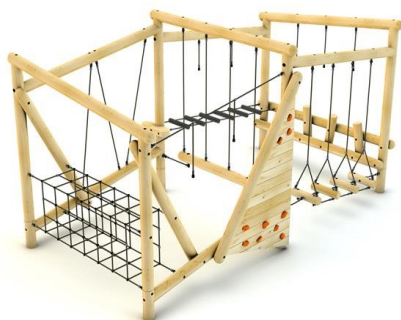
Happy Friday everyone!
