Public consultation on plans to manage primary school places in the Yeadon and Guiseley areas of Leeds

Due to the decrease in birth rates and surplus places in a number of schools in the area, Leeds City Council (LCC) is consulting on a proposal to close Queensway Primary School when term ends in July 2023. The consultation started on 26 September and will run for four weeks.
