This week we welcomed two new members of staff to the team. Mr Martindale had previously been employed by us from an agency and Miss Murgatroyd is new to Y1 Pear.

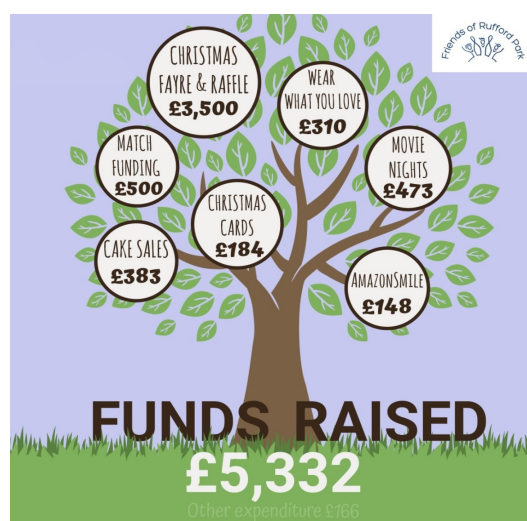
